The airline will connect Piedmont to the capital of Hungary with flights operated on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

The flights will be operated from the 28 October 2025 with **three weekly frequencies** (Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday) and are on sale as of today with fares starting **from 24.99 euros²** on the airline's website <u>www.wizzair.com</u> or on the <u>carrier's mobile app</u>.

In Winter season 2025/2026, there will be 6 destinations in the company's network connected by Torino Airport: in addition to the new entry **Budapest**, there will also be **Bucharest**, **Catania**, **Iasi**, **Tirana** and **the Warsaw ski route**.
