

## WIZZ AIR ANNOUNCES A NEW ROUTE FROM TURIN TO SUCEAVA

*Two weekly flights, operating every Monday and Friday, with the new service set to launch on 18 December 2026, further strengthening connectivity between Northern Italy and Romania.*

Caselle Torinese, 28 August 2026 – **Wizz Air**, Italy's second-largest airline by market share, continues to invest in **Turin** and is expanding its network with a new international destination: **Suceava**, in north-eastern Romania. Following the announcement of the opening of its base in the Piedmont capital, which will become operational on 14 September, the airline is adding another destination to its network, strengthening connections between Piedmont and Eastern Europe.

Thanks to the strong partnership with **Torino Airport**, the new direct **Turin–Suceava** service will begin operating on **18 December 2026**. The route has been designed to offer passengers a gateway to the Bucovina region and to serve the sizeable Romanian community in the Piedmont capital. Tickets are on sale from today, 28 August, on the Wizz Air website and via the official WIZZ app, with fares starting from **€24.99**.

The new service will operate **twice weekly, on Mondays and Fridays**, offering passengers a convenient direct travel option for discovering one of Romania's most fascinating regions.

The new service marks a further step in Wizz Air's growth in Turin, following the recent announcement of four new routes to **Wroclaw, Gdansk, Katowice and Prague** and ahead of the opening of the **new base at the Piedmont airport**. The base will operate with **two aircraft**, the first from 14 September and the second from 25 October 2026, progressively expanding the airline's offering. This investment consolidates Turin's role as a key hub for air mobility in the region and strengthens Piedmont's connectivity, creating new travel opportunities to domestic and international destinations.

With the addition of the new route, Wizz Air's network from Turin for the **2026/2027 winter season** will expand to **23 destinations**, including **5 in Italy and 18 abroad**. This broad and diversified offering will connect the Piedmont capital domestically with **Catania, Lamezia Terme, Naples, Palermo and Rome Fiumicino**, and internationally with **Barcelona, Bilbao, Bucharest, Budapest, Chisinau, Gdansk, Iasi, Katowice, London Luton, Madrid, Malaga, Prague, Sharm el-Sheikh, Suceava, Tirana, Valencia, Warsaw and Wroclaw**. This continuously expanding network reflects Turin's increasingly central role in the airline's growth plans, with Wizz Air currently holding a **17.4% market share** at the airport.

**Salvatore Gabriele Imperiale, Corporate Communications Manager at Wizz Air**, said: *"With the new direct route to Suceava, Wizz Air is introducing a new Romanian destination from Turin, following Bucharest and Iasi, and adding another component to an increasingly international network. This service brings Piedmont closer to Bucovina and has also been developed to meet the travel needs of the sizeable Romanian community in Turin and across Piedmont. For us, it*

means being even closer to our passengers and the communities we serve, offering direct and affordable connections that increasingly respond to their travel needs. The Suceava route is part of our continued growth in Turin, where the airline has put a total of 1.3 million seats on sale in 2026. We are only at the beginning of a project designed to make Turin increasingly connected with Europe and beyond. Let's WIZZ, Turin!"

**Paolo Papale, Aviation Development Director at Torino Airport**, commented: "Wizz Air's launch of the new service to Suceava responds to a tangible mobility need expressed by the local area and by the significant Romanian community living in Piedmont. The new route will make travel between the two regions easier, supporting not only those travelling for family or work reasons, but also opening up new opportunities for tourists seeking affordable destinations, unspoilt natural landscapes and experiences off the beaten track."

Confirming its growing investment in the Piedmont capital, Wizz Air put approximately **690,000 seats** on sale to and from Turin for summer 2026, an increase of **148%** compared with summer 2025.
