New Turin-Kyiv flight: SkyUp Airlines expands its network in Italy

Caselle Torinese, 12th December 2019 - On December 12, 2019, SkyUp Airlines completed its first flight from Kyiv to Turin. It will now be possible to fly twice a week from the capital of Ukraine to the important economic and industrial center of Italy.

From now on, Ukrainians have the opportunity to explore one more region of Italy and discover new cities in this incredible country. At the same time, it is important for us to open Ukraine to the world. We are glad that we will now be able to show our capital to Piedmont residents. Kyiv is one of the oldest cities in Europe, rich in cultural and historical sites. At the same time, the city is modern and dynamic", said Yevhenii Khainatskyi, Chief Executive Officer of SkyUp Airlines.

SkyUp Airlines flies to about fifty destinations using its scheduled and charter services: among the international destinations served, Alicante, Antalya, Barcelona, Bodrum, Burgas, Dalaman, Dubai, Hurghada, Larnaca, Palma de Mallorca, Naples, Nice, Rimini, Sharm El Sheikh, Tenerife, Teodo, Turin and Varna. SkyUp domestic services connect in Ukraine Kyiv, Kharkiv, Lviv, Odessa and Zaporizhia. As of 1st October 2019, the airline transported 1,567,478 passengers since the launch of its flight network in May 2018.
