Torino Airport, flights update December 1st, 2019 Airspace reopens after war device disarming

Caselle Torinese, December 1st, 2019 – Torino Airport informs that, following the closure of the airspace today December 1st, 2019 scheduled from 9.30 AM to 4.30 PM for the operations of defusing a war device found in Via Nizza in Turin, the number of flights involved was 17 arriving and 15 departing.

Following the successful completion of the bomb clearance operations, the airspace over Turin was reopened early at 1.50 PM.

The airlines, in the time slot concerned, have changed the schedules of 9 incoming flights and 7 departing flights, which have therefore been operated to and from Turin.

The remaining 8 flights arriving and 8 departing have suffered hijacking or cancellation: in detail, 4 flights arriving and 2 departing were diverted to Milan Malpensa; 4 incoming and 6 departing flights have been canceled.

The airlines have promptly informed and re-protected the passengers involved.
