AT TORINO AIRPORT THE SECURITY CHECKPOINTS OF THE FUTURE: LIQUIDS, GELS AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL NOW BE LEFT IN CARRY-ON LUGGAGE FOR A MORE CONVENIENT AND FASTER TRAVEL EXPERIENCE

Installed at the Fast Track priority gate, the innovative radiogenic machine enables 3-D checking of hand luggage contents, enhancing passengers' travel experience. Additional initiatives to meet travelers' needs: increased charging points and new Working Area

Caselle Torinese, August, 2 2022 – More convenient and faster security checks at Torino Airport to improve the passengers experience. The airport is looking to the future and continuing the process of innovation focusing on the passenger: thanks to the installation at the Fast Track priority passage of an innovative X-ray apparatus that allows for three-dimensional scanning of the contents of carry-on baggage, it is no longer necessary for passengers using the Fast Track passage to separate either liquids or electronic devices.

Fast Track is accessed by passengers who have this priority service included in their airfare, or who decide to purchase it on Torino Airport's e-commerce platform or directly at the airport using the automated checkout machine.

Tablets, PCs and smartphones, as well as liquids, aerosols and gels (such as water bottles, cosmetics and food) will now be able to be left inside carry-on baggage instead of being separated in special trays. This speeds up the time it takes for passengers who choose Fast Track to pass through security gates, improving the travel experience while **meeting all the standards set for screening**.

The new X-ray apparatus meets the C3 standard stipulated by European Union Regulation 1998/2015, allowing for complete screening of carry-on baggage: in fact, it is a device that **produces high-resolution 3D images**.

In any case, security procedures stipulate that, depending on the response provided by the apparatus and the security officer, it may be necessary to carry out further checks, providing for the opening of the baggage and targeted screening of certain items.

This is a further step on the path of constant innovation for Torino Airport: the airport, **among the first in Italy to be equipped with the latest generation of security devices**, thus reconfirms its attention to the needs of the passenger and its willingness to always look to the future.

To effectively meet the needs of travelers, Torino Airport has created a **Charging & Working Area**. Located beyond the security checkpoint, in the boarding gates area, it will be accessible free of charge for those who need to use computers, **offering 11 workstations each equipped with 2 USB sockets and electrical outlets to recharge smartphones and tablets**.

Torino Airport thus increases the offer of charging points, making the travel experience and stay at the airport even more comfortable: also thanks to the installation of additional new stations located in the boarding area, the possibility for passengers to recharge their electronic devices doubles. The wi-fi coverage service inside the Passenger Terminal is also enhanced.

Many innovations also on the parking front: **the entire range of official Torino Airport parking lots is in fact now available online** with very convenient rates **starting from 4 euros per day**, and all parking points are accessible through automatic license plate reading mode for a smooth and increasingly touchless travel experience.
