From 2013 to 2017 as Chief Commercial Officer of Meridiana redesigned the carrier's commercial strategy and redefined the network and implemented a new distribution strategy.

In 2017, following the entry of Qatar Airways into Meridiana as a shareholder and primary industrial partner, he held the role of Chief Commercial Officer of Air Italy, accompanying the transformation from a charter carrier to a schedule international airline.

He has also been Executive Committee Member of Assoclearance (Italian association for airport clearance and slot coordination), Managing Committee Member of Assaereo and Board of Directors Member of Air One S.p.A..

In January 2019 he has been appointed Chief Executive Officer of SAGAT S.p.A., the company responsible for the management and development of Torino Airport.

He is also Chairman of SAGAT Handling S.p.A., Chair of the ACI EUROPE's Regional Airports' Forum, Vice-Chair of the "Gruppo Turismo e Cultura dell'Unione Industriali di Torino", member of the Executive Board of Assaeroporti (Italian airports association) and member of the Executive Board and the General Council of "Unione Industriali Torino".
