



RYANAIR'S NEW TURIN-LIVERPOOL ROUTE FOR WINTER 2025/2026 TAKES OFF

Ryanair, Italy's No. 1 low-cost airline, announced today (Thursday, December 11th) that the first flight of its new 2025 Turin-Liverpool winter route is taking off this week, on Saturday, December 13th. Ryanair will operate one flight per week on this exciting new 2025/2026 winter route, offering Italian and Piedmontese customers even more choice and regular connections at the lowest prices in Europe.

Fabrizio Francioni, Head of Communications Italy at Ryanair, commented:

"We are thrilled to see the first flight of our new 2025 winter route from Turin to Liverpool take off this week. This connection further strengthens Turin and the Alps of Piedmont as a preferred winter holiday destination for tourists from the United Kingdom, while also connecting Piedmont with a vibrant city known for its musical heritage and iconic promenade, perfect for a winter city break.

This route is just one of 31 in our 2025 winter program to/from Turin, where Ryanair will offer 1.5 million seats at low-cost fares this winter, a 30% increase. Furthermore, for the first time ever, we will have a third aircraft based in Turin during the winter, representing a total investment of \$300 million.

Working closely with Torino Airport team, we have shown that competitive fares and efficient operations are the key to fostering growth. Further to this, Ryanair calls on the Italian government to eliminate the municipal surcharge at all airports. If it were removed, Ryanair would respond with a growth plan for Italy that includes 40 more aircraft, 20 million additional passengers, 250 new routes, and 15,000 new jobs throughout Italy."

Andrea Andorno, CEO of Torino Airport, said:

"We are delighted that Ryanair is launching a new Turin-Liverpool flight for the 2025/2026 winter season. With the addition of this new destination, Ryanair will now connect Turin directly to seven UK airports, confirming the importance of this market for our region. Ryanair's growth at our airport, with the addition of a third aircraft based here, enables us to offer our passengers not only new destinations, but the richest winter ever. Many destinations we serve, such as London Stansted, Madrid, Dublin, Porto, Brussels Charleroi, Copenhagen, Malta, Marrakech, and Seville, are recording significant increases in weekly frequencies".
