

**NEW RECORD FOR TORINO AIRPORT  
THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS TRANSPORTED IN 2024 HAS  
ALREADY BEEN EXCEEDED**

*New connections and increased frequencies on existing destinations are driving growth.*

*Caselle Torinese, 12 December 2025* – Yesterday Torino Airport surpassed the traffic record set in 2024, which saw it record a total of 4,693,977 passengers. As of December 11<sup>th</sup>, 4,694,975 passengers have already been transported. There are still twenty days until the end of the year and the forecasts remain very positive.

The month of November exceeded the 400,000 passenger threshold for the first time and was up 15% compared to the same month in 2024. The 2025/2026 winter season, which began on October 26<sup>th</sup>, thus opens with growth and with the widest range of seats ever offered for sale to fly to and from the Piedmontese airport.

This significant increase is driven by several factors, including the addition of a third Ryanair aircraft based in Turin, with new routes to Liverpool and Pescara, and increased frequencies to many destinations. Other contributing factors are the new routes to Eastern European cities like Budapest and Sofia with Wizz Air, and the extensive offerings related to snow tourism.

But the news doesn't end there: starting tomorrow, December 13<sup>th</sup>, Wizz Air will be flying to Chisinau, and from December 20<sup>th</sup>, Aer Lingus will connect Turin and Dublin up to twice a week. Finally, the latest addition for the Christmas holidays is a flight to the premier Red Sea destination, Sharm el-Sheikh, operated by Neos (Alpitour World).

With 20 countries connected, 12 new routes, 7 new destinations, and 15 destinations – including 8 international ones – experiencing a significant increase in frequencies, the airport is confirmed as a strategic point of reference for tourism and connectivity in the Northwest.
