

LONDON CALLING: WIZZ AIR AND TORINO AIRPORT ANNOUNCE NEW DIRECT FLIGHT FROM TURIN TO LONDON LUTON

The airline continues to invest in Turin, expanding its services and connecting two key European business and tourism hubs.

CASELLE TORINESE, December 23, 2025 – Wizz Air, one of the leading airlines in Italy, chosen by more than **20 million passengers** in the country this year, continues its expansion from Turin: as of today, sales are officially open for the new flight to **London Luton**. The airline and **Sagat**, the management company of Torino Airport, are thus consolidating their partnership, offering travelers a network of destinations that is increasingly rich, accessible, and at the **lowest possible price**.

The new connection, operated **three times a week (Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday)**, will take off during the next summer season on **June 13, 2026**, enriching the links between Northern Italy and the British capital. Tickets for the new route are already available on **wizzair.com** and through the official **WIZZ app**, with fares starting from **€19.99**.

London needs no introduction: it's one of the world's most iconic and vibrant capitals, constantly reinventing itself. From the historic buildings of the City to the lights of Piccadilly Circus, the British metropolis remains an unmissable destination that combines timeless charm with avant-garde flair. A destination everyone should visit at least once in their lifetime.

From today, experiencing the energy of London is even easier for those departing from **Turin**. Thanks to the new direct connection operated by Wizz Air, the British capital becomes a reachable and affordable destination for all travelers departing from the region. A service designed for those seeking comfort, efficiency, and competitive fares to reach one of the most sought-after destinations in the world.

The launch of the **Turin-London Luton** route confirms the importance of Torino Airport in Wizz Air's growth strategy in Italy and the consolidation of the airline's presence in Piedmont. This announcement follows numerous routes launched by the company from Torino Airport in recent months—most recently, the connections to **Chisinau, Sofia, and Budapest**—testifying to how much the carrier believes in Turin's potential and how proactive and structured the partnership with Sagat is.

With this new expansion, Wizz Air continues to boost the region's connectivity, offering increasingly diversified and accessible travel options, further strengthening the strategic importance of **Torino Airport**. This commitment is confirmed by the 2025 operational results: this year alone, the company operated over **2,000 flights**, carrying more than **438,000 passengers**. Operational excellence is reflected in the reliability and capacity data, with a **completion rate of 99.8%** and a capacity increase during this Winter Season of **56.2%**.

Salvatore Gabriele Imperiale, Corporate Communications Manager of Wizz Air, commented: "With the new connection to London Luton, we continue to strengthen our presence in Italy—a country we consider an absolute priority for our global strategy and which is already our company's top market by passengers carried. The choice to invest in Turin once again, following the launches of Sofia and



Budapest, demonstrates how much we believe in the potential of this territory and in the response of Piedmontese passengers. This route not only shortens the distance to one of Europe's most dynamic metropolises but also reaffirms our mission: to offer quality international travel that is affordable for everyone, supporting connectivity and local economic development."

Andrea Andorno, CEO of Torino Airport, stated: "We are delighted to end the year by announcing this important news. The new flight from Turin to London Luton strengthens our collaboration with Wizz Air. 2026 will be full of news, also thanks to Wizz Air, which has recently inaugurated flights to Budapest, Chisinau, and Sofia."

In total, across Italy, the airline operates over **250 routes to 32 countries** with a fleet of **29 Airbus A321neo** aircraft, serving **26 airports** in the country. In 2025, the airline carried nearly **21 million passengers (+8% compared to the same period in 2024)**, operating over **93,000 flights** to and from the country with a **completion rate of 99.8%**.
