



## THE NEW FLIGHTS TO SOFIA AND BUDAPEST KICK OFF TODAY WIZZ AIR EXPANDS ITS NETWORK FROM TORINO AIRPORT

The airline connects Piedmont to the capitals of Bulgaria and Hungary, with the addition of the new Turin - Chisinau route soon to follow

The new connections expand the range of destinations accessible from Torino Airport and enrich the network with two vibrant capitals rich in history and culture.

Famous for its thermal baths, imperial architecture and vibrant nightlife, the Hungarian capital is a well-established destination offering activities for all tastes. Among the city's unique experiences, a Danube cruise and a visit to the majestic neo-Gothic parliament are not to be missed.

**Sofia** captivates with its authentic blend of nature and history. The Bulgarian capital, now connected to Turin for the first time, is renowned for its Orthodox churches, Roman ruins, and the majestic Vitosha Mountains that surround the city, offering breathtaking views. Thanks to its rich cultural offerings, Sofia is an emerging destination with steady growth in the tourism sector, but also an ideal starting point for an adventure: from the seven Rila Lakes to discovering Plovdiv, the ancient city built on seven hills, Bulgaria is a country with authentic charm.

The flight schedule includes three weekly frequencies to Budapest on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, and two weekly flights to Sofia, with the addition of a third flight during the Christmas period. The flights will be operated with the ultra-modern Airbus A321neo aircraft and tickets are available on wizzair.com and through the official WIZZ app, with fares starting from just €24.99¹.
