

## THE SHAREHOLDERS' MEETING OF SAGAT SPA APPROVES THE PARENT COMPANY'S 2025 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND THE 2025 SUSTAINABILITY REPORT

*Caselle Torinese, 26 May 2026* – Today, the Shareholders' Meeting of SAGAT S.p.A. approved the Parent Company's 2025 Financial Statements and the SAGAT Group's 2025 Consolidated Financial Statements, which closed with a **positive net result of €6.8 million**.

The main economic indicators are as follows:

- Value of production: **€63.5 million**
- EBITDA: **€11.9 million**
- Net profit: **€6.8 million**
- Investments: **€11.1 million**
- Net financial debt: **€7.4 million**

### **SAGAT Group's 2025 Sustainability Report has been published**

The SAGAT Group has also published its **2025 Sustainability Report**, which transparently details the company's contribution to achieving its ESG objectives, in line with a long-term strategic vision.

Having integrated sustainability into its corporate strategy through its Sustainability Mission, Sustainability Policy, and multi-year Sustainability Plan, the SAGAT Group is now providing its stakeholders with a document that details the progress of its key initiatives undertaken throughout 2025.

Key findings from the 2025 Sustainability Report include:

- 2025 was **another record year for airport traffic, with 5,006,169 passengers** handled, an increase of **6.7%** compared to 2024 and **26.7%** compared to 2019, the last year before the pandemic. It is also the first year the airport has surpassed the 5 million passenger mark;
- in 2025, Torino Airport received the **ASQ Award as the "Airport with the Most Dedicated Staff in Europe"**, a recognition that highlights the dedication and commitment of the airport staff in ensuring a high-quality passenger experience;
- Torino Airport has maintained its **Level 3+ "Neutrality" certification under the ACA-Airport Carbon Accreditation programme**, confirming its path towards decarbonisation and the **Net Zero target by 2040**;
- in 2025, the airport's photovoltaic system was further expanded and generated **2,209 MWh of electricity**, covering **17% of the airport's energy needs**. The remaining electricity was purchased from a certified renewable source with a Guarantee of Origin;
- **58% of the airport's vehicle fleet** is made up of hybrid or electric vehicles, and there are **41 electrified charging stations** available at the airport;
- the SAGAT Group continued its work on the **Torino Green Airport** project and the European **TULIPS** consortium. In 2025, this included ongoing trials for producing and using green hydrogen at the airport;

- in terms of social sustainability, the SAGAT Group is strengthening its **commitment to the local community and future generations** through **structured collaborations with local schools and academic institutions**, as well as training and guidance programmes. **In 2025**, the Group's companies delivered training and internship projects as part of the **Pathways for Transversal Skills and Guidance (PCTO)** programme, aimed at **78 students**, launched **6 internships**, and involved a total of **120 students** in projects carried out with schools and training institutions, thus facilitating their entry into the world of work;
- according to **ACI Europe's Economic Impact Calculator** model, the direct economic impact generated by companies operating directly at the airport amounts to **€225.8 million**.

**SAGAT SpA:** Since 1956 SAGAT-Società Azionaria Gestione Aeroporto Torino SpA has held the concession for Torino Airport, which runs until 2037 with the option to extend for a further 20 years. SAGAT SpA is controlled, through 2i Aeroporti (51% F2i and 49% Asterion), by the Terzo Fondo Infrastrutture, established and managed by F2i SGR, Italy's leading infrastructure fund manager.

SAGAT SpA is the parent company of the SAGAT Group, which includes the airport handling company SAGAT Handling. The latter is wholly owned by SAGAT SpA and operates at Torino Airport.
