

Finnair and Torino Airport: New direct flights to Helsinki take off on May 3rd
The service will operate year-round, opening the door to the “happiest country in the world” and to Finnair’s global network for passengers departing from Piedmont.



Turin, April 21st, 2026 – Finnair and Torino Airport announce the launch of a new direct flight between **Turin and Helsinki, starting May 3rd**. This strategic route marks a key step forward for regional connectivity, providing a year-round flight that will link the capital of Piedmont to the Finnish hub.

During the summer season, the service will operate up to three times a week. During the winter season, the route will continue to operate with one weekly flight, which is also confirmed for the peak winter sports period from January to March.

“Italy is a strategic market for Finnair, and the launch of this year-round route from Turin reinforces our commitment to improving connectivity between the ‘Bel Paese’ and our hub in Helsinki,” said **Geoffrey Carrage, Finnair Regional Manager for Southern Europe**. *“With the launch of this flight, we aim to offer travelers an even more accessible, comfortable, and sustainable flight experience, with direct connections to Finland and beyond, while responding flexibly to the needs of an increasingly discerning clientele.”*

“Finnair’s arrival at Torino Airport is a highly valuable development for our airport and for the region: for the first time, people in Piedmont have a direct, year-round connection to Finland and, via the Helsinki hub, to an extensive international network.” *“This flight offers new opportunities to Asia and North America, with flight*

From the vibrant city of Helsinki to the magical landscapes of Finnish Lapland, which can be reached year-round on Finnair flights departing from its Helsinki hub, Finland invites you to discover the secret of its serenity.

Access to Finnair's global network

In addition to connecting the two cities, the flight to Helsinki serves as a prime gateway to Finnair's extensive intercontinental network. Thanks to convenient connections via the Helsinki hub, passengers departing from Turin will be able to easily reach major destinations in Asia, such as **Japan**, where Finnair operates flights to Tokyo Haneda and Narita, Osaka, and Nagoya, as well as major cities in **North America**, including Los Angeles, Dallas, and **Toronto**, Canada, where the new route will be launched on May 4th.
