

WIZZ AIR LAUNCHES A NEW ROUTE FROM TORINO AIRPORT TO SHARM EL SHEIKH

*The new scheduled service to the Red Sea starts on 27 October 2026,
with tickets on sale from today.*

Caselle Torinese, 16 July 2026 – **Wizz Air** is expanding its offer from **Torino Airport** and announces a new route that will enhance the company's network from its new base in Piedmont. The direct connection to **Sharm el-Sheikh** is starting in the 2026/2027 winter season, connecting Turin with the **Red Sea** via a scheduled flight for the first time. Tickets are on sale from today on wizzair.com and on the [official WIZZ app](#) with fares starting from **€45.99**.

The flight to **Sharm el-Sheikh**, operating **on Tuesdays and Saturdays from 27 October 2026**, is one of the main new additions to the Wizz Air network from Turin: the new route will offer passengers from Piedmont a direct connection to one of Egypt's most popular destinations during the winter season, ideal for holidays full of relaxation, snorkelling and a mild climate all year round.

The new connection is part of the growth path initiated with the opening of the new Wizz Air base in Turin, which will see the arrival of two aircraft based at the airport: the first from 14 September and the second from 25 October 2026. Thanks to this investment, the company continues to strengthen Piedmont's connectivity by offering new travel opportunities for both leisure and family or business travel.

With the new route announced today, the Wizz Air network from Turin for the Winter 2026/2027 season will reach a total of **20 destinations**, including **4 domestic** and **16 international**. The offer will include domestic connections to **Catania, Naples, Palermo and Rome Fiumicino**, as well as international routes to **Barcelona, Bilbao, Bucharest, Budapest, Gdansk, Iasi, Katowice, London Luton, Madrid, Malaga, Prague, Sharm el Sheikh, Tirana, Valencia, Warsaw and Wroclaw**, confirming Turin's role as a strategic market for the company's growth.

Salvatore Gabriele Imperiale, Corporate Communications Manager of Wizz Air, said: *"As the opening of our new base in Turin approaches, we continue to shape, route by route, the growth project we have built for Piedmont. After recently strengthening the connections dedicated to incoming tourist flows to the Piedmontese mountains, today we are looking at the needs of local passengers and adding Sharm el Sheikh to our network, offering a new direct connection to the Red Sea during the winter season. This is exactly the value of a Wizz Air base: developing an increasingly broad and diversified network, capable of creating new travel opportunities and responding to different mobility needs. With two aircraft based there and 20 destinations in the Winter 2026/2027, Turin is playing an increasingly important role in our growth in Italy. And we are only at the beginning. Let's WIZZ, Turin!"*

Paolo Papale, Director of Aviation Development at Torino Airport, commented: *"The announcement of the new route to Sharm el Sheikh, which for the first time connects Turin to the Red Sea with a scheduled flight, is great news for our airport and for passengers from Piedmont. This development confirms the value of the path taken with Wizz Air and helps to further expand travel opportunities from Turin to highly attractive national and international destinations."*
